

MOVEMENT DAY™ NEW YORK

A New Kind of Gathering

The prototype of Movement Day was launched in 2010 and focused on planting new churches, training thousands of leaders (marketplace, pastoral, and social sector), and strengthening Movement Day. As a result of this, we celebrated:

- Sixty new church plants that contributed to growth of evangelical Christianity in Manhattan by 30,000 people in five years, much more than any one church or network could do on its own.
- The training of 26,000 leaders as we created multiple entry points from our cumulative efforts through different ministries.
- Attendance of over 11,000 leaders from 360 cities at Movement Day. This was possible only because multiple agencies were committed to the collaborative model.

The results of this Project 1.0 are the pragmatic expression of Jesus' prayer in John 17.

We also recognized some intangible results:

- Value-added collaboration results in a more robust Gospel ecosystem.
- The vibrancy of the Gospel is in proportion to the depth of the unity of the church.
- The complex needs of the city require a highly collaborative model, increasing our cumulative impact.
- The growth of each other's capacity as we work together, which is profoundly more impactful than just growing one agency much larger.

The results of Project 1.0 after five years is a clear illustration that when the church of Jesus Christ works together, our efforts are multiplied.

Pulpit Exchange and Overcoming a Tragedy

In 2013, a group of church and business leaders invited NYCLC to launch Movement Day Greater Dallas (MDGD). While Dallas is known for its array of large churches, these leaders expressed dismay at the cultural divides in the Dallas Church. In January, 2014 MDGD was born.

Over 5,000 leaders attended MDGD events in 2014-2016. It is remarkable that over 500 ministries collaborated together in and around these events, a first for Dallas. At the inaugural MDGD, a seasoned Dallas leader was overwhelmed with the diverse display of believers together in one room and declared, "never in my lifetime have I seen this."

In partnership with MDGD and in a distinct display of unity, Explore God mobilized thousands of discussion groups in hundreds of churches in a unified thrust to explore big questions about God life meaning and purpose.

Hooked by the biblical call for racial reconciliation, two prominent Dallas area pastors – one from a predominantly white church (Jeff Warren) and one from a predominantly black church (Bryan Carter) – exchanged pulpits in March 2015, an event picked up by the national media. It was at MDGD that these two pastors forged a strong relationship. In 2016, sixteen culturally diverse pastors swapped pulpits on a Sunday morning. In 2017, we anticipate up to fifty pastors will exchange pulpits.

This past summer five Dallas police officers were slain in a tragedy that deeply impacted the city. Immediately the mayor of Dallas called Jeff Warren and Bryan Carter to pull the clergy of Dallas together. The relationship of Pastors Warren and Carter reflects the bridge-building capacity that Movement Day brings to a city.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why do you believe that the global cities strategy is one of the most important mission strategies for world Christianity today?

Not only are the rural poor moving into cities at an unprecedented rate, but cities are increasingly dominant in determining which messages get listened to in their whole region. Of course, it is important to finish reaching all people groups in undeveloped regions, but it is essential to mobilize the church in the fastest growing areas.

What is the evidence that God is already working, through this strategy?

As NYCLC's founder and his team travel to four continents, they are greeted by local leaders already hungry to convene the church in their city. In some cases, they visit Movement Day in New York and see the potential. We believe the spread of this idea around the world in a few short years is evidence of God's blessing.

What actually happens in a city when Movement Day is planted?

It starts by sitting down with church leaders in very different sections of a city, who rarely speak with each other or may have racial and cultural differences, and getting them talking. Then God's people from around the city meet together in united prayer, and an event is planned with the help of our experienced meeting planners.

How do we measure results?

An early indicator of God's favor in a city is attendance at Movement Day, which has grown in New York every year. Three even more important measures of effectiveness in accelerating the Gospel are continuing united prayer for the city, united projects to proclaim the Gospel, and multiplied works of compassion for the poor.

CITY CHAMPIONS

City Champions will underwrite the launch of a fresh Gospel movement to which they feel most called. City Champions will sponsor the advance teams who parachute into complex cultures to win support and organize, including a marketplace mobilizer, church unifier, prayer facilitator, and Movement Day specialist.

Within the City Champions vision are key opportunities to fund the strategic components necessary to launch a city. These components are designed to work in concert with one another, establishing a crucial infrastructure for each city to become part of the Global Cities Network.

UNDERSTANDING THE LAUNCH OF A CITY MOVEMENT

Ambassador Visits are in response to requests from city leaders around the world for strategic conversations in Movement Day formation. In addition to the 2017 Movement Day cities, requests are 'in' from Poland, Jakarta, Hong Kong, Alexandria/Cairo, and Mumbai to meet with leaders in their city.

City Research – Good research compels action. Armed with compelling research, the informed Church is poised to rally around common challenges, and establish powerful agreement on what needs to be done and what they can accomplish together.

Marketplace Mobilizer – Men and women in the marketplace are vital to Movement Day formation and success. A marketplace mobilizer will convene and resource city marketplace leaders, affirming their unique role in the success and sustainability of a city Gospel movement.

City Leadership Seeding – Leadership for emerging collaboration in a city is imperative. Leverage occurs as we seed fund an emerging leader in a city/region on the front end of Movement Day formation.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT CHAMPIONS

Leadership Development Champions will support the leveraged work of investing in a new generation of indigenous Gospel visionaries from global cities. These visionaries will be trained by a Movement Day Institute at Nyack College in New York and at an Emerging Leader Institute in Dallas. Through an investment in talented and dedicated believers from all over the world who are passionate about the Gospel, Leadership Development Champions will help raise the effectiveness of Gospel witness all over the world. Their motivation is augmented by expertise and best practices among our students.

Within the City Champions vision are key opportunities to fund the strategic components necessary to launch a city. These components are designed to work in concert with one another, establishing a crucial infrastructure for each city to become part of the Global Cities Network.

TRAINING A NEW GENERATION OF LEADERS



Movement Day Institute in NYC – Leaders from around the world are eager to experience a Movement Day expression in their city/region. On the heels of Movement Day Global Cities, an Egyptian business leader requested, "Please help us form a movement in Egypt that rises to a Movement Day expression."

The Movement Day Institute is a five-day MD immersion held in New York City, October 2017. The Manhattan Christian Collaboration Center at Nyack College in downtown NYC serves as the site for the Institute.

Fifty leaders from emerging Movement Day cities will come together and journey together in a learning lab to explore the building blocks for a sustained Movement Day expression. Participants will think through how best to contextualize Movement Day components into their city/region. The Institute will culminate with involvement in MDNYC 2017.

Emerging Leader Gathering – The acceleration of the Gospel hinges on our ability to reach and empower young leaders in big cities. It is stated that most spiritual movements are started by people who made their faith commitment before the age of twenty, and distinguished themselves as leaders before the age of twenty-eight.

Born between 1981 and 1997, the 18 to 34-year-old emerging leader represents an underutilized, underrepresented cadre of leaders. It should be among our highest priorities to develop these emerging leaders who can create the long-term leadership pipeline needed to impact a city for the next 20–40 years. Finding the "26+" leaders in a city is perhaps the most crucial goal of an existing leadership team or cluster of organizations. We believe this requires a unique and independent effort.

The Emerging Leader Gathering, hosted in Dallas TX, will convene 250 younger leaders to connect, pray, and discern together God's leading of their generation for global mission in cities. We believe this gathering will 'move to the front' of emerging leaders, while forming lifelong friendships and ministry partnerships.
